



Dunigan Branch Part-time Position

Position: Child Watch and/or Youth Activity Center (YAC) Attendant

Overview: To provide a safe, supervised play environment for the children of the YMCA, while members and guests remain on the premises.

Assignment: Child age ranges are infant to 5 years of age in Child Watch and 5 years of age to 12 years of age in the Youth Activity Center (YAC).

Position Description:

Attendants will be responsible for the safety and well-being of each child under their supervision, as well as the interaction and engagement with the children under their care. All attendants must take turns facilitating craft activities, songs, story-time, and creative play for children. Staff are expected to enforce health codes and good hygiene, as well as be familiar with emergency procedures.

Hours will be assigned to all attendants by the Youth Member Services Coordinator and all attendants are responsible for finding a shift substitute in they are unable to work. Shift requirements are a minimum two weekday shifts per week and a minimum two weekend shifts per month.

Requirements:

New Employee Orientation, Child Abuse Prevention (CAP), and Blood-borne Pathogen (BBP) training must be completed before the attendant's first shift in the Child Watch and/or YAC rooms, and CAP/BBP must be renewed every year. First Aid, CPR, AED, and Oxygen training must be completed within the first 60 days of hire and renewed every two years.
