Thank you for your interest in the Y's Summer Day Camp programs! We strive to provide a safe and happy day camp experience for you and your child. This booklet is designed to provide your family with the information needed to make the best choice for your child's valuable time while out of school.

BECOME A Y MEMBER AND \$AVE!

Remember that YMCA members enjoy early access to registration on February 9th as well as discounted Summer Day Camp fees. These rates are noted throughout the guide as (YM), and membership must remain active through all registered camp weeks to receive membership benefits and pricing.

If you're not currently a Y member, consider an official membership. The member discount for one month of camp would pay for a family membership so the whole family can stay active this summer. A family membership is only \$79 per month and includes access for the whole family to the Ascension St. Vincent Y, Dunigan Family Y, and Toyota Indiana YMCA. **Non-member registration (NM) for Summer Day Camp will not be available until February 23rd.** Financial Assistance applications are now available for both members and non-members.

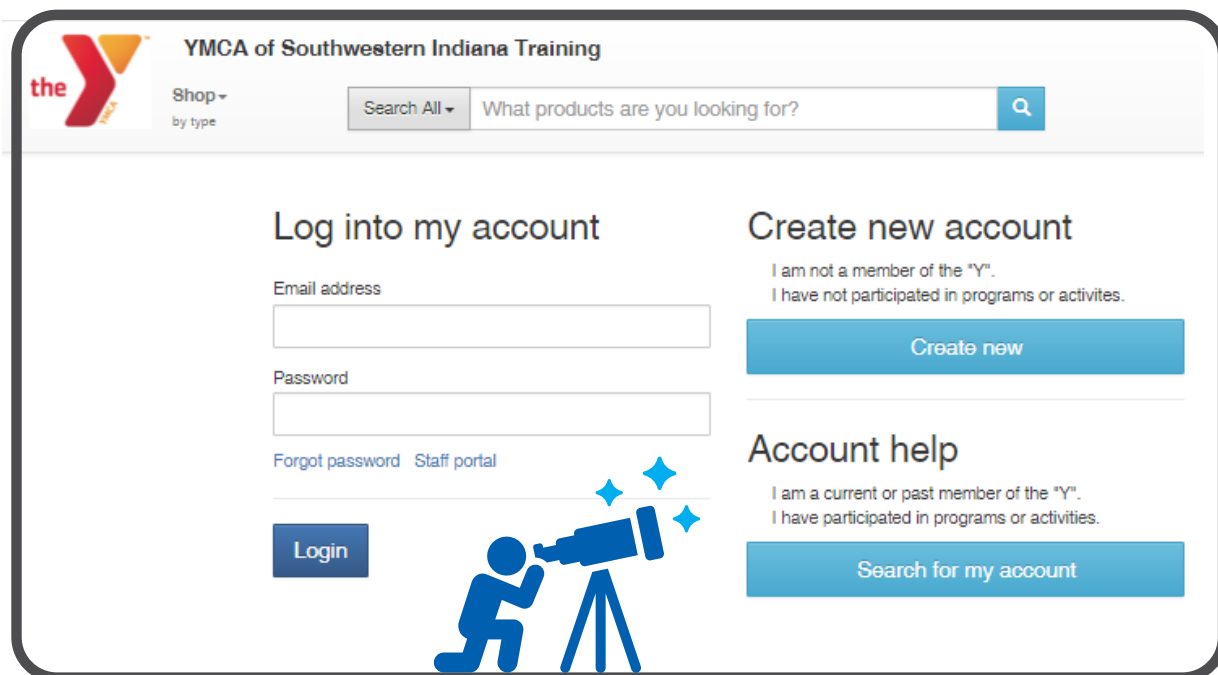

ONLINE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

Click site of your choice in our child care guide or click **Register Today**. These diagrams and steps outline the online registration process.

1. If you're an active member with an email on file, simply enter your email and password in the **Log Into My Account** section to the left.
2. If you're a member but don't remember your account email, click **Search for My Account** to the right.
3. If you are not a Y member, click **Create New** to the right.

NOTE: An email address is required to create an online account.

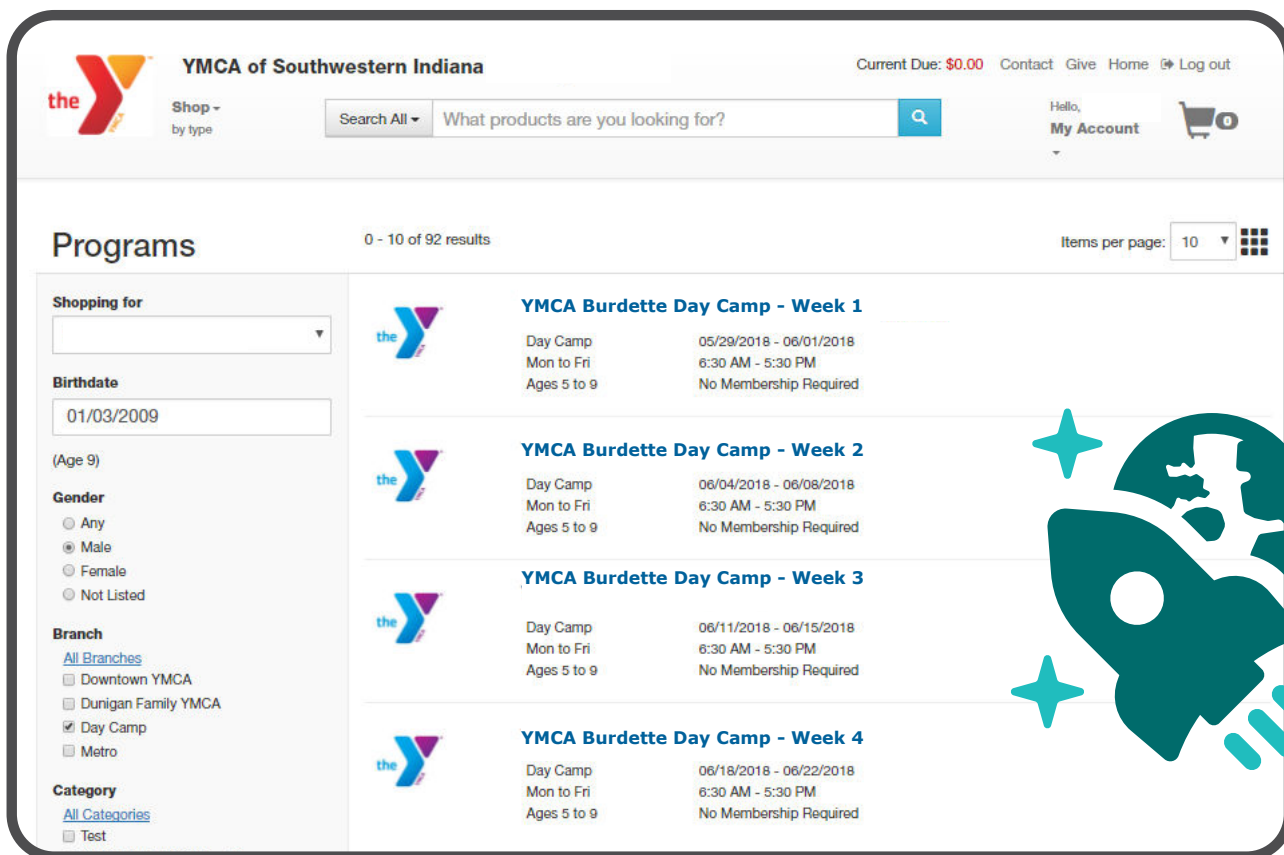

4. Once signed into your account, complete your account setup with your and your child's information. Click **Shopping For** on the left and choose your child's name. Click **Shop by Type** in the upper left and choose **Day Camp** to see weeks your child is eligible and begin adding weeks for that child to your cart. When all weeks have been added to your cart, click the **Shopping Cart** icon in the upper right. **NOTE:** When registering more than one child, be sure to change the **Shopping For** menu to change children. Add all weeks for all your children to your cart before proceeding to check out to ensure that you receive the sibling discount.

5. In the cart, complete the required registration forms; if you are registering for more than one child, you must complete this form for each individual child. You will not be able to check out until the registration form is complete. A one-time \$70 registration fee will be applied per child.
6. Weekly fees are due the Monday before the child attends camp. Your Cart defaults to a payment plan based on this weekly schedule. To pay in full, click **View Payment Plan** in Cart and click **Remove Payment Plan**. Then click **Proceed to Checkout** to finish registration.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

In an effort to make our fees affordable for all, the YMCA provides financial assistance using a sliding fee scale based on annual gross household income and family size. The YMCA of Southwestern Indiana makes every effort to ensure that no person, especially youth, will be denied access to programs and membership because of financial hardship. The YMCA's Financial Assistance Program is supported by contributions to our Annual Campaign.

Financial Assistance applications are available to both members and non-members. To be considered for financial assistance your application must be filled out completely and turned into either YMCA location with proof of income.

Financial assistance will be awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis until all available spaces are filled so submit your request as early as possible.

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

Registration fees are non-refundable under any circumstance. To adequately serve as many families as possible, we've updated our Cancellation policy. To cancel a registered week, you must complete an online cancellation form at www.ymcaswin.org/summerdaycamp.

ANY AND ALL CANCELLATIONS FOR THE SUMMER MUST BE SUBMITTED BY APRIL 7TH. *THERE IS A 7 DAY GRACE PERIOD IF YOU REGISTER FOR CAMP AFTER THE APRIL 7TH DATE.

AGES 4-12

At the YMCA, we provide safe, affordable, and fun child care for preschool children ages 4-5, elementary school children ages 5-9, and a camp for pre-teens ages 10-12, from May 28 to July 31. Our summer day camp program provides a range of activities, to entice everyone's interest, in an atmosphere that reinforces the values of caring, honesty, respect, responsibility, and faith. Kids will enjoy a summer full of nature, water fun, games, sports, arts & crafts, and new friendships.

ACTIVITIES

Daily rotations will vary depending on that week's theme, but could include activities like swimming, STEM, art activities, team building, sports, or group games. We offer a wide variety of activities, all structured to foster learning and personal growth for your child.

SWIM LESSONS

Day Camp Swim lessons allow you to take advantage of your summer at the Y! Your child can stay at the Y and receive quality swim instruction by our trained Aquatics Staff. This special add-on is available for all summer day camp sites for a flat fee of \$70 for the entire summer. Campers will attend lessons once per week at either our Ascension St Vincent or Dunigan Family branch.



THE Build *What Matters* **PLACE**

STAFF LEADERSHIP

Every parent wants their child to have great role models and we've found them! Our staff are selected based on experience working with children, maturity, sound judgment, and sensitivity. Safety is our top priority and every member of our team is trained in CPR, First Aid, and Child Abuse Prevention in addition to completing an extensive training in supervision, behavior management and camp procedures. Our staff to child ratio varies by camp but will never exceed 1:10.

MEDICATION

If it is necessary for your child to take medication while in our care, please fill out the medication form included in the online registration forms. All child prescriptions are to be given directly to a staff member when you sign your child in. All medications must be in their original container with written directions for delivery and written parental consent is required for us to administer any medication. Medications are stored out of reach of children. We maintain a record of administration on a medication log.

BEHAVIOR POLICY

Day Camp Staff make every effort to ensure each child has a positive experience. Our behavior expectations and policy will be shared with parents upon registration. Parents are expected to review the expectations with their child. Failure to comply with program behavior guidelines could result in removal from the program without a refund.

SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS

The YMCA of Southwestern Indiana will make every attempt to make reasonable accommodations for program participants requesting special assistance. When filling out the registration form, you will be asked if you are requesting a special accommodation be made for your child. In order for your child to make the transition to camp as smooth as possible and to have the most positive experience, it helps us to know about anything that might affect your child's ability to participate fully and successfully. The only reason we need this information is to prepare for your child in a way that supports their participation in camp. Providing us with this information will help us in creating a positive and supportive experience for your child. If you select yes a Child Care Coordinator will contact you to learn more about your child.

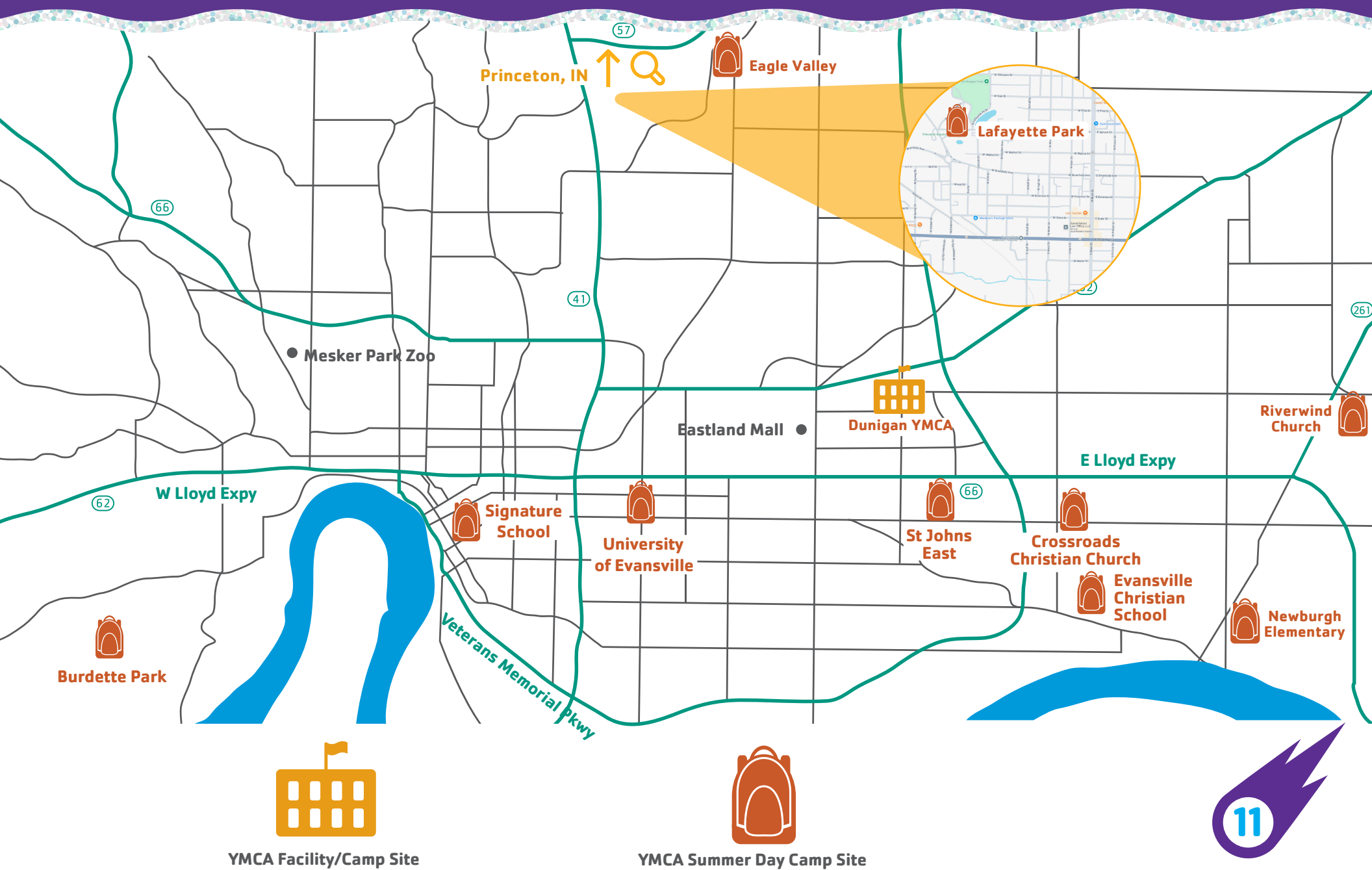
*All necessary personal items that come to camp should be clearly labeled with the camper's name. Items that are lost will be placed in a lost and found area.
